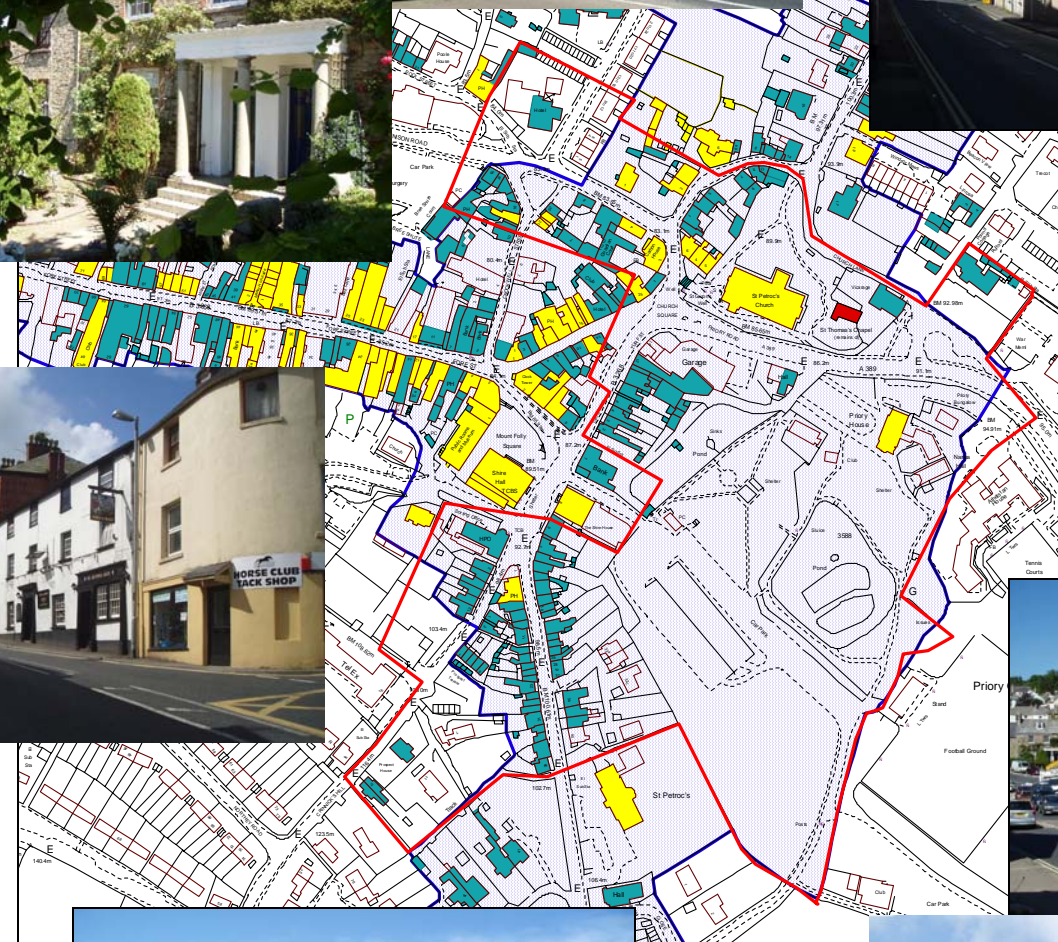
This sheet summarises the comprehensive assessments of character and regeneration opportunities in Section 7 of the report.

Character summary

This Area fringes and is secondary to Bodmin's commercial and civic core (Character Area 1). It includes St Petroc's church, some large houses, residential streets and open green space.

Regeneration opportunities

- Seek reduction in traffic levels; improve pedestrian facilities.
- Promote appropriate development of sites on Priory Road / Church Square.
- Maintain the well-kept park character of the former priory grounds.
- Improve presentation and interpretation of historic monuments in the area.
- Improve the quality of public realm provision.
- Apply robust conservation management to historic buildings, backed if necessary by new Article 4 directions.
