

**Character Area 1c:  
Chapel Street**

This sheet summarises the comprehensive assessments of character and regeneration opportunities in Sections 5 and 6 of the report.

**Character summary**

An extraordinarily fine historic streetscape, with an assemblage of historic buildings of very high distinction and charm. Formerly one of the main axes of the medieval town, it now presents an air of quiet gentility, underpinned by a range of predominantly 'quality' uses.

**Regeneration opportunities**

• **Review promotion and visitor access**

Promote and signpost Chapel Street within the town, especially to the casual visitor; review access by public transport.

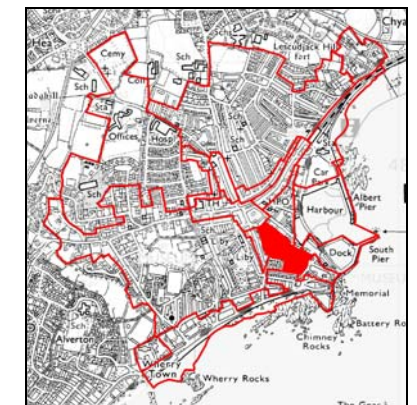
• **Maintain quality uses**

The distinct sense of place of Chapel Street derives from the quality of its streetscape and buildings and from uses which avoid brash, cheap or inappropriate signage and alterations. Maintaining such uses is important. Character can be further enhanced by restoration of specific high profile and high quality individual buildings. Reinstating the Georgian theatre would create an additional visitor draw as well as providing a unique resource for the local community.
