

Character Area 3:

Lemon Street

This sheet summarises the comprehensive assessments of character and regeneration opportunities in Sections 7 and 8 of the report.

Character summary

Distinctive townscape of the highest quality, with views up and down the sloping street providing some of the defining images of Truro. Although diverse in detail it has a fundamental unity of character based on the genteel elegance and modest scale of the dominant architectural style.

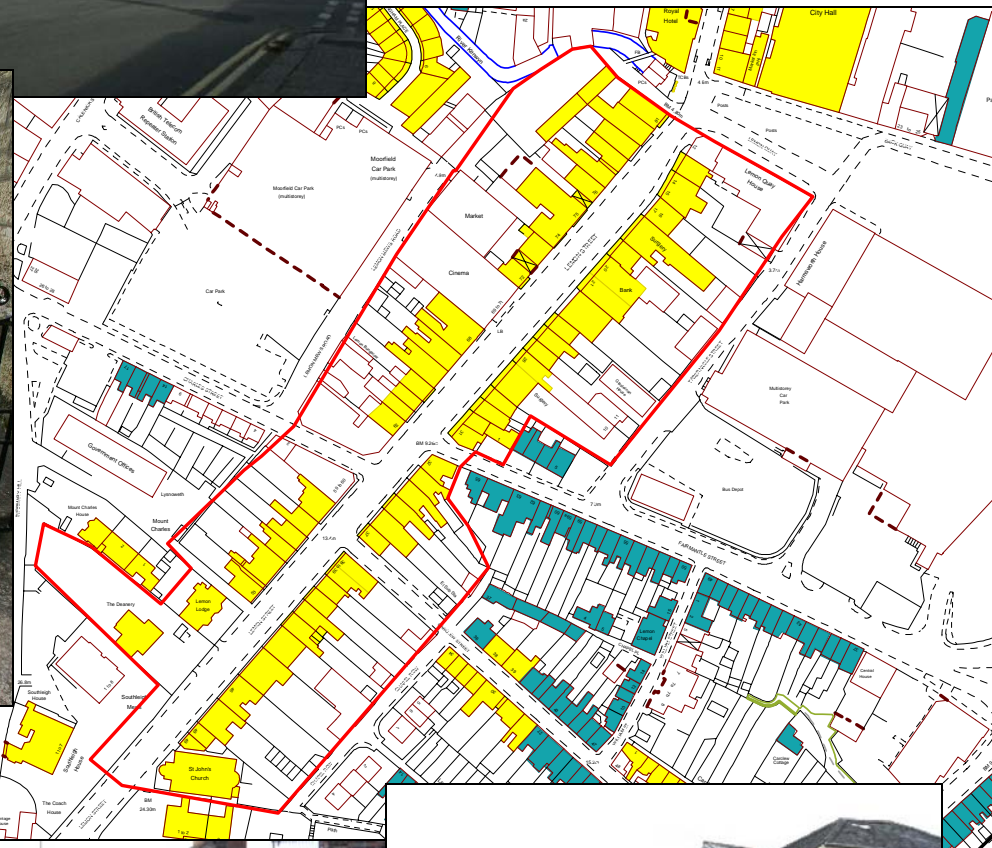
Regeneration opportunities

Lemon Street contributes substantially to Truro's sense of place. Its regeneration significance is in both the quality of individual buildings and the whole townscape.

- **Maintain the asset.** Ensure that all works are of appropriate quality and authenticity. This applies to the public realm (such as surfacing and lighting) as well as to buildings.
- **Monitoring and management.** To consistently achieve high quality works an agreed management plan should be drawn up and adhered to.
- **Enhance approaches.** Improve the experience of Fairmantle and Charles Streets as thresholds to Lemon Street on the inner ring road.
